APPLICATION



BKK is based on silanes and siloxanes which form a water-repellent matrix within the masonry. With a low molecular weight **BKK penetrate deeply** into the

BKK is a transparent, breathable, water-repellent treatment for brick, concrete and stone walls. It is applied to the wall surface using a roller or brush. Once BKK has been applied to the wall surface and cured, it form a water-repellent barrier.

Please note: Larger cracks and mortar lines will still need to be filled or repointed with a sand/cement or sand/lime mix before applying BKK.

The product should only be applied to dry, porous surfaces. Do not apply on to sealed or painted surfaces.
